TEAM QUICKPLAY TOURNAMENT

Saturday 22 February 2020, 12:45pm till 4:45pm, at America Hall, De La Rue Way, Pinhoe, Exeter, EX4 8PX

(Ample parking is available at the venue, which is a 6-minute drive from Junction 29 of the M5, or a 9-minute walk from Pinhoe train station)

Format: Teams of <u>four players</u>. Six rounds will be played under a Swiss pairings system

(based on total game points scored). Digital clocks will be used, with each player

receiving 10 minutes plus 3 seconds increment per move.

Trophies: All teams will compete in one 'pool', and three team trophies will be awarded:

Overall winner: **Thomas Trophy** [2018: Exeter A]

Best team under 600 total grade: **Hodge Trophy** [2018: Exeter B / Plymouth A]

Best team under 450 total grade: **Graded Trophy** [2018: Sidmouth]

The Individual Performance Trophy will be awarded to the player achieving the

best individual score [2018: Tom Thorpe, Exeter / Graham Bolt, Exeter]

Entries:

Clubs are strongly encouraged to enter more than one team – there is no limit on entries! Teams from non-Devon clubs are very welcome to participate, although they will not be eligible to win any of the four trophies. Instead, a small prize will be awarded to the highest-placing non-Devon team.

The entry fee is ± 12 per team (payable on the day) for a team of four adults. Thanks to a donation, a £1.50 discount may be applied for each junior (aged under 18 on 1/9/2019) – e.g. a team of four juniors pays an entry fee of £6.

Entries should be notified in advance (ideally by 15 February 2020, please) to Dr Tim Paulden (DCCA President) at timpaulden@gmail.com - player names are not required, but your attention is drawn to the rule below on estimated grades. If you do not have email access, please enter by sending a text message to 07809 464639. All entries will be confirmed upon receipt. Please get in touch if you have any 'spare' players – it may be possible to create a composite team! ECF Rapidplay grades (January 2020 list) will be used where available, and

Standardplay grades (January 2020 list) otherwise. Estimated grades must be official and pre-approved with the organisers, or the team in question will not be eligible to win a grade-limited trophy. Results will not be sent for grading.

- Please note: 1. Depending on entries, clubs may be asked if they can assist by bringing a small number of boards / sets / clocks to the event, which will be carefully managed and tracked to avoid any mixing. The organisers would be grateful if clubs could indicate soon, via email, if they are happy to help in this way.
 - 2. Light refreshments (drinks & biscuits) will be available for a small donation.
 - 3. We intend to run an (entirely separate) individual blitz tournament earlier on the same day (10am-12pm) at the same venue. Email timpaulden@gmail.com if you might be interested in playing! Full details will be released in due course.
